## **COLLECT FOR 2 BEFORE ADVENT**

Heavenly Father,

whose blessed Son was revealed to destroy the works of the devil and to make us the children of God

and heirs of eternal life:

grant that we, having this hope,

may purify ourselves even as He is pure;

that when He shall appear in power and great glory

we may be made like Him

in His eternal and glorious kingdom; where He is alive and reigns with You,

in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

## **REFLECTION FOR 2 BEFORE ADVENT**

I often hear people say, 'I am a Christian but I don't go to church.' And I wonder how they can live out a faith in isolation. My understanding from the Bible is that Christianity is a communal faith. It is a faith that lived out within a community of believers.

Luke tells us that the early believers:

devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer... Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts.

This was against a backdrop of persecution. For those early believers, the risk of persecution was outweighed by the desire to meet together, to worship together, to learn more about their faith.

Sadly, as the Christian faith spread, some started to lose this desire, this need to meet together regularly. The writer of Hebrews has to say to his readers:

Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing...

Today there are pressures on our time. There are some who do have to work on a Sunday, for some it is a need to spend time with the family.

As a church we need to create opportunities for people to meet together, to pray together, to worship together, to learn together.

I love the Message translation of that verse from Hebrews:

Let's see how inventive we can be in encouraging love and helping out, not avoiding worshiping together as some do but spurring each other on, Hebrews 10:24-25 (MSG)

And for ourselves, we need to ask, 'Does my desire to meet with God, to worship Him, to be in fellowship with fellow believers outweigh all other considerations?'

We are blessed that there is worship every Sunday of the year across our Benefice. Let's hear those words from Hebrews, and make meeting together our priority, wherever, whenever, and however.
