REFLECTION: Trinity 5

There's a film, 'Dogma', as part of which the church is trying to update the image of Jesus.

The idea they come up with is 'The Buddy Christ', big grin, white, with flowing locks, giving a big thumbs up!

I grew up with the suggestion that Jesus is our best friend:

The best friend to have is Jesus

The best friend to have is Jesus

He will hear me when I call:

He ill keep me lest I fall,

Oh, the best friend to have is Jesus.

And, of course He Himself said:

I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.

John 15:15 (ANIV)

But our belief in the Trinity means that Jesus is so much, much, more.

Paul says in Colossians:

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by Him and for Him. He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. And He is the head of the body, the church; He is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything He might have the supremacy.

So we have this dichotomy, this tension, these two ideas. On the one hand we sing:

'What a friend we have in Jesus, all our sins and griefs to bear'

whilst also singing:

'Lord, enthroned in heavenly splendour'

We don't believe in a 'buddy Christ', but in the King of kings, enthroned in heavenly splendour, who calls us His friends.
