REFLECTION: Trinity 16

So the person discerned to be 106th Archbishop of Canterbury was announced on Friday.

The Rt Revd and Rt Hon Dame Sarah Mullally DBE, currently Bishop of London.

Bishop Sarah said:

"As I respond to the call of Christ to this new ministry, I do so in the same spirit of service to God and to others that has motivated me since I first came to faith as a teenager.

"At every stage of that journey, through my nursing career and Christian ministry, I have learned to listen deeply – to people and to God's gentle prompting – to seek to bring people together to find hope and healing.

"I want, very simply, to encourage the Church to continue to grow in confidence in the Gospel, to speak of the love that we find in Jesus Christ and for it to shape our actions.

"And I look forward to sharing this journey of faith with the millions of people serving God and their communities in parishes all over the country and across the global Anglican Communion.

"I know this is a huge responsibility but I approach it with a sense of peace and trust in God to carry me as He always has."

I pray that God will guide Bishop Sarah in this task to which she is called, and that the fruit of the Spirit—love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control - may be seen in the way in which she leads the Church of England, and also works within the wider Anglican Communion.

*Almighty and Everlasting God, the only worker of great marvels;
send down upon Your servant Sarah, called to be Archbishop of Canterbury,
and all who are committed to her care
the Spirit of Your saving grace;
and that they may truly please You
pour upon them the continual dew of Your blessing.*
