REFLECTION: Epiphany 2

We talk a lot about 'calling' in our Christian lives, often in terms of a particular ministry. Tom has been called to ordination, Dick has been called to Eldership, Harry has been called to be a Reader.

But the reality is that each one of us is called.

Jesus called the first disciples to follow Him, to become 'fishers of men'. And He makes the same call to each one of us. We respond to that call when we each start on our own journey of faith, becoming learners of and from Jesus.

There is a sense in which this is a call-back; a call back to living in relationship with God, a call back to living in His love. In the Garden of Eden, God walked and talked with Adam and Eve. And it is this sort of relationship which God desires to have with each one of us – being intimately involved in God's divine dance of life.

Everyone is invited, everyone is 'called-back' by God, to join the dance. Our family, our friends, our neighbours, are all invited to join in.

Throughout the Bible we are told to call back those around us.

Jesus said, 'Therefore go and make disciples of all nations ...' Matthew 28: 19

Jesus said, 'The harvest is plentiful but the workers few. Ask the Lord of the Harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field' Matthew 9: 37

We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us ... : Be reconciled to God 2 Corinthians 5:20

God makes His invitation, His call back, through us, each one of us. As Charles Wesley wrote,

*Ye servants of God, your Master proclaim,
and publish abroad His wonderful name;
the name all victorious of Jesus extol:
His Kingdom is glorious, and rules over all.*
